Greetings!

There is so much to share this Summer! I'll try to keep it brief and bulleted. The end of the fiscal year is a good time to look back and look forward, to reflect on what has transpired over the last year and to set goals for the coming year. Here are some TTN outcomes that I am especially excited about:

- **Fifteen (15) agencies graduated from our first year-long Trauma-Informed Care (TIC) Learning Community on June 7th! They all improved on at least 5 of 7 TIC domains and 10 agencies improved on all 7 domains!** This becomes even more significant when you realize that most agencies worked on 2-3 domains and none of them worked on more than 4. - **One agency group of 12 from Central Clinic and 24 individual professionals from a variety of agencies completed the requirements to become Trauma-Responsive Care Certified!** This is our first year offering this certification in conjunction with Finding Hope Consulting, LLC. Read more about [Trauma-Responsive Care Certification](#) (TRCC). A new series will start in December and you may also request to have the trainers come to train staff at your agency.
- **TTN hosted 16 training/education events (including our 8-module TRCC series) this past fiscal year and I gave an additional 6 trainings at agencies and outside workshops. Our total attendance to date at all trainings hosted and provided since August 2015 is over 1900!**
